DECLARATION OF CINDY ANTHONY

I, CINDY ANTHONY, hereby declare and affirm under oath, pursuant to § 92.525, Fla. Stat., that the following facts are true and correct:

1. I am an adult over eighteen years of age and I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein.
2. I am the mother of Casey Anthony, the Defendant in this matter, who I refer to hereinafter as “my daughter” or “Casey.”
3. On July 25, 2008, I visited my daughter at the Orange County Jail. The visit was videotaped by the Sheriff’s Department. A true and accurate copy of the video is attached as Exhibit CA2.
4. During that visit, my daughter told me that “when [the Orange County Sheriff’s Office] went and interviewed that girl down in Kissimmee, they never showed me a picture of her.” My daughter complained that law

enforcement was looking for the nanny by the wrong name and would not call in a sketch artist so that they could create a drawing of the woman she described. Casey repeatedly told me that the “nanny” she had referred to in her statements to law enforcement was not “Zenaida Gonzalez” or “Zenaida Fernandez” but was “Zenaida Fernandez-Gonzalez.” She complained that the Sheriff’s Office was not looking for the nanny by her “full name.” I clearly understood from what Casey told me that the “girl down in Kissimmee” was not the person Casey had identified to law enforcement and I never told any one otherwise.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare this 19th day of March, 2012, that I have read the foregoing document and I declare that the facts stated in it are true.
